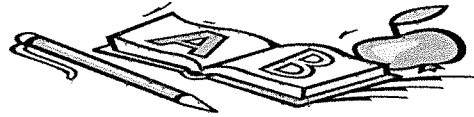

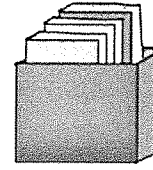
Please bring your child's supplies to **Open House**.

**Classroom Supplies:**

Please **DO NOT** label with names unless noted. We use community supplies.

1. Large backpack to carry folder (no rolling backpacks) labeled with name
2. One large box of tissues
3. Two large pink erasers
4. **Expo brand** Dry erase markers -8 markers (in colors blue, black, green, red only)
5. Yellow No. 2 pencils (pack of 10-12)
6. One tub of Lysol wipes (**GIRLS**) or 1 large bottle of hand sanitizer (**BOYS**)
7. Ziploc plastic bags (**GIRLS – Gallon Freezer bags with slide closure**) (**BOYS - quart size**)
8. One 3-prong pocket folder

**Your child will need a nutritional snack daily. Water is the only drink allowed in class.**

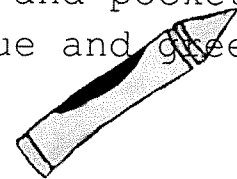
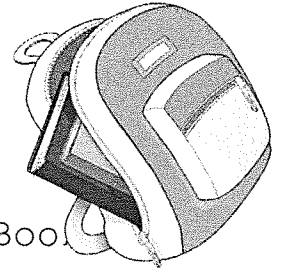
- \_\_\_ 2 Boxes of Crayons (24 count or larger)

- \_\_\_ Sturdy Clipboard (Label with Name)
- \_\_\_ Ziploc Bags: **Girls- Gallon Size Boys- Sandwich Size**

Optional: Headphones (send in Ziploc bag and Label with name)

# Second Grade Supply List 2017-2018

- Thirty yellow pencils with erasers
- Four large pink, rectangular erasers
- One box of 25 count crayons (no larger)
- Two composition books (Mead Composition Book Style)
- **Pencil pouch for supplies (No larger than 8x10, canvas wears best. This is in place of traditional pencils boxes. The students will not need a pencil box.)**
- 4 pocket folders with three prongs and pockets, one of each color (red, yellow, blue and green)
- 2 regular size boxes of tissues
- Washable Markers- 1 pack
- Dry erase markers (4)- broad tip, Black color only
- Boys - quart size **freezer** bags
- Girls - gallon size **freezer** bags

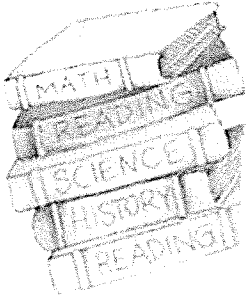

  - 2 large boxes of tissues

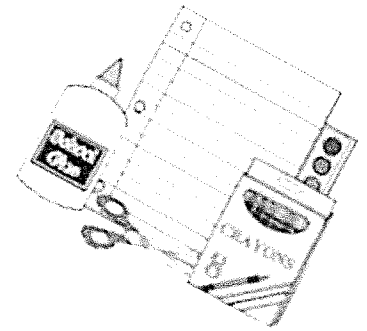
All supplies will be collected as community supplies. Please do not put names on any supplies. We will label them as needed for school.
